WHEN GOD'S PEOPLE SAY YES



A decade ago, Watermark Health launched our first clinic location at 9780 LBJ Freeway.

Though it was an unprecedented experiment, the building blocks for impact were there - a church dedicated to serving its neighbors, talented medical professionals, the reality of a gap in the healthcare system, and most importantly, a faithful God who provides. The team came together with a shared vision and hope, and said, "Let's give it a shot! Let's see what happens."

What happened?
The church met the city's needs.

Our first patient came in with flu-like symptoms, not realizing she was pregnant. Beyond addressing her healthcare needs, our team spent hours counseling her on the decision for her child's life after she asked for directions to an abortion clinic. They continued to support her for years, even hosting a baby shower—a collective 'yes' to loving those God placed before them.

Beginning with this mother and child, God has provided countless chances to embrace the significant vision He has for us. WMH is not just a healthcare clinic; it is an outpost of the local church - addressing our city's needs in tangible ways and directing people to the love and power of the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

In the following years, patient volumes increased, and I joined the team, tasked with scaling the ministry. I thought we might be able to launch a second clinic in five years, but through God's provision, the Plano clinic launched in two! Since then, He's added a mobile clinic, dental services, early prenatal care, and hypertension management, shaping WMH into what it is today.

Reflecting on the past decade, it is truly shocking to realize all the Lord has accomplished in our midst. We've witnessed miracles—from refugees finding community via a dental visit, to women escaping abuse because a nurse asked one extra question, to Muslims embracing the gospel because their child needed a school physical, to volunteers' lives changing as they meet people from all over the world.

From humble beginnings, the Lord has authored a beautiful story of people coming together for a common good. It is an honor and a privilege to be part of it.



Early Prenatal Care

From day one, WMH has been deeply committed to women's health. Over the past decade, this commitment has been elevated to new heights with the establishment of our Early Prenatal Care (EPC) Line.

The vision for EPC began with our very first patient, and developed over the years as our team and volunteer OBGYNs continued to see gaps in women's health in our community. In 2021, sonogram services were added to slowly add to our ability to serve. After the Roe v Wade reversal in 2022, there was an increased need from area PRCs which led to expanding into a full-service line, equipped with a state-of-the-art GE sonogram machine, a dedicated staff team, and expanded scope of services.

In just a few months of operation, EPC has already seen almost 90% of expectant mothers choose life. We are thrilled about the limitless potential of this service line and the meaningful ways we can support women during one of the most vulnerable seasons of their lives.



The Power of Partnership

From strengthening existing partnerships to establishing new partners, 2023 marked a year of collaboration.



This year, we proudly established an official partnership with the Texas Health Resources' Faith Community Nursing Program. This collaboration empowers us to broaden our impact on community care and join forces with fellow medical professionals in our shared mission.



From staff development to volunteer training, the principles of "When Helping Hurts" have helped to shape our approach to caring for folks from marginalized communities. This year, we embraced a special opportunity to partner with Chalmers on a featured piece for their platforms. We are incredibly thankful and awestruck to be highlighted by an organization that has played such a transformative role in our ministry.



Since forging our partnership with OurCalling in 2020, we have provided support to over 700 of our neighbors experiencing homelessness, and the numbers continue to grow. This year. the leadership of both organizations came together to envision larger and more impactful ways to collaborate in the future.

WHY SKILLMAN CROSSING?

The city council member over District 10 at the time pointed us to this location. This zip code is consistently ranked with some of the lowest health outcomes and highest socioeconomic needs in DFW. The area is also home to a large refugee resettlement with many individuals who have never navigated the US Healthcare System before.

In 2014, volunteer teams were developed and deployed.



On average, 150-200 volunteers serve annually within the various Watermark Health clinics and service lines.

Over the years they have been encouraged and trained through international discipleship trips, training days, and volunteer celebrations.

YEAR 3

In 2015, we expanded to include dental services. Aligning with the urgent care focus, the primary emphasis was on dental extractions, aiming to ease pain and provide an alternative to the ER for related pain management.

Did you know that Collin County has no county hospital? In 2017 alone, over 6,000 Collin County residents drove down to Parkland to be served in the ER. In 2018, Watermark Health was incorporated as a nonprofit to oversee the multiple locations and service lines.

Texas is ranked 48th in the country for overall healthcare outcomes and coverage. The Mobile Clinic helps to bridge this gap by its deployment in strategic community locations, including weekly visits onsite at OurCalling and Watermark South Dallas

We plan to launch new Urgent Care locations, with at least three in the pipeline. Stay tuned for more details as plans progress!





We aim to broaden and refine our 'Powered By' model, making it more accessible for a wider range of non-profits and churches.
